

1. Preparing to travel

When talking about the Holy Spirit to your children, be sure to let them know that he is a person and is given the attributes of personality. He has emotions, actions, intellect and relationships. He is also God, and has attributes such as omnipresence and omnipotence. He performs miracles, helped in the creation process, and is involved in our own salvation. He is the third person of the Trinity, but equally important.

2. On board

Read and discuss these scriptures and questions with your children.

Personality: Ephesians 4:30

Is grieving a feeling? So what does this tell us about the H.S.?

What are some of his other personal attributes?

Deity: 2 Corinthians 13:14

Is each person of the Trinity seen here? What is the attribute of the H.S. in this passage?

Salvation: The Holy Spirit is instrumental in personal salvation.

Find out how in John 16:8, Titus 3:5, Romans 8:9, 1 Cor. 12:13, Eph.1:13-14.

Gifts: 1 Corinthians 12:4-11

Ask your child what they like to do and what they are good at. Are these areas gifts?

How could they use these abilities to serve the Lord?

4. Help you child find ways they can use their gifts to serve the Lord, at church and at home.

5. Pray with them and thank the Lord for these gifts and ask for his help in using them for his work.
