1. How would the people of our world define sin? Example of sin.
2. Discuss the origin of sin. Where did it originate?
3. Does the Bible define sin?
4. List other words in the Bible that are used in place of sin?
5. Are there places in the Bible where some sins are listed?
6. How would you personally define a sin in your own life as you would stand before God?

The Fall

1. What do Satan (Is. 14:12-15) and Eve (Gen. 3:1-6) and Cain (Gen. 4:1-6) have in common.
2. Is there a lesson or a principle that can be drawn from the 3 examples above for our living today?
3. Explain why it would be said that sin is a wrong view of God, of Self?
4. When it is so evident that there is a cost to sin, why is it seldom taken into consideration before sinning?
5. Why would it be said that the two primary sources of sin is pride & anarchy?

The Corruption of Sin

1. Take time to read and reread Romans 1:18-32 & 2:5-11 to discover as much as possible about what God's Word says about those who continue sinning

The Rebellion & God's Grace

1. Describe stages or the steps of the slippery slope of sinning as seen in the example of Eve in Gen. 3:6.A
2. Give Scripture to combat each one of the steps listed above. (Jesus answered Satan with Scripture, so must we!)
3. Rebellion is described as what in Ps. 14:1 & *Prov. 28:26. How, where & why does this apply to today's culture?*
